Designed for:

Experienced operators who wish to become NPORS Registered Instructors

Course Aim:

The overall aim of the course is to:

- Provide learners with a thorough understanding of relevant Legislation, Codes of Practice, British Standards
- Provide learners with a thorough understanding of Instructional Techniques
- Enable learners to be able to prepare and deliver classroom and practical lesson plans in line with NPORS standards and requirements

Course Content:

- NPORS Operator Theory and Practical Tests to Instructor standard on relevant machinery*. (***NB, this test will be conducted on day one of the course and must be successfully achieved to be able to progress with the rest of the course**)
- Legislation and guidance
- The Role of the Instructor
- Principles of Instruction
- Skills Analysis
- Preparation and Planning
- Preparation and delivery of classroom lesson plans
- Preparation and delivery of practical lesson plans

At the end of the course learners will undertake 3 examinations. These will consist of a theoretical examination, delivery of a classroom lesson and the delivery of a practical lesson. To help achieve positive outcomes learners may be required to do some work at home in the evenings.

Duration: 10 Days – Maximum of 4 candidates per course

NB: An NPORS Instructor Application form will need to be completed prior to course attendance, and supporting documentation will be required e.g., Current C.V., copies of current accredited operator certificates etc.
